JORDAN

Oh, that's just dirt.
(eyes start tearing up and it all falls right off but she tries to make it look cool)

SEBASTIAN

Hello ladies.

ALEX

Hello, gentlemen.

SEBASTIAN

I can tell you're not good at rock climbing.

FRANCESCA

How can you tell?!

EMILY

(stepping in)
Ignore her. She's not. We are.

ALEX

Yeah, plus, we have other really great skills.

JORDAN

(trying to save it)
Including rock climbing.

ALEX

And what the rest of us lack in climbing skills, we make up for in passion and enthusiasm.

JORDAN
Alex stop talking.

BEN
What are you, the cheerleaders?

FRANCESCA
(trying to be intimidating)
Yeah we're about to cheer-lead all over
the place.

SAMMY
We're gonna cheer-lead over there. We're
gonna cheer-lead over here.

SEBASTIAN
Emily, control your women, please.

EMILY
No, I like them this way.
